APPROVING ACADEMIC COUNCIL Resolution No. 6, Series of 2020

"A RESOLUTION FOR THE OFFICIAL START OF CLASSES FOR THE
1ST SEMESTER, ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-2021 OF COLLEGE AND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL"

WHEREAS, Article III Section 6 of the City Ordinance No. 60 s. 2016 generally known as **The New Charter of Mabalacat City College**, the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* empowers Mabalacat City College to exercise the general powers prescribed by this Ordinance in order to carry out and perform the powers and functions are hereby vested exclusively by the Board of Trustees;

WHEREAS, Article II section 7 (q), of the City Ordinance No. 60 s. 2016 generally known as **The New Charter of Mabalacat City College**, the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* of Mabalacat City empowers the Board of Trustees to exercise and perform such other powers and functions not inconsistent with existing law or ordinance as it may deem necessary for the effective and efficient governance of the College;

WHEREAS, the Academic Council Meeting was convened by the Vice President for Academic Affairs, Dr. Renato Dan A. Pablo II, and attended by the Institute Deans, Senior High School Director, Registrar, Head Librarian, and Student Affairs and Services Coordinator; Mabalacat City College (MCC), as an institution of higher learning recognizes the importance of providing the best possible and high-quality education to its stakeholders;

WHEREAS, in order to deliver quality instruction to students despite logistical restrictions brought about by the recent pandemic, it was found necessary to postpone the opening of classes for the 1st Semester, Academic Year 2020-2021;

WHEREAS, according to Republic Act 7722 better known as the Higher Education Act, the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) issues guidelines for universities and colleges in deciding on their academic calendar;

WHEREAS, the CHED Chairperson reiterated in a recent media interview that “universities open their school year as approved by their board depending on the way they structure their semesters”;

WHEREAS, in order to address the present academic needs, Mabalacat City College will be adapting a Flexible Learning Scheme where the semester will be divided into two (2) cycles consisting of six (6) modules each.

WHEREAS, Cycle 1 of the 1st Semester will run from September 28 to November 7, while Cycle 2 will be from November 9 to December 19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees, through its 3rd Quarter Meeting herein assembled to approve the Academic Council Resolution No. 6 series of 2020 that the 1st semester of the Academic Year 2020-2021 be officially opened on September 28, 2020.

RESOLVED further that a copy of this resolution be furnished to the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mabalacat City, Pampanga and other concerned offices.
