**RESOLUTION NO. 01**  
Series of 2020

**APPROVING THE MERGING OF INSTITUTE OF ARTS AND SCIENCES (IAS) AND INSTITUTE OF TEACHER EDUCATION (ITE)**

**WHEREAS**, Article III Section 6 of the City Ordinance No. 60 s. 2016 generally known as **The New Charter of Mabalacat City College**, the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* empowers Mabalacat City College to exercise the general powers prescribed by this Ordinance in order to carry out and perform the powers and functions are hereby vested exclusively by the Board of Trustees;

**WHEREAS**, Article II section 7 (q), of the City Ordinance No. 60 s. 2016 generally known as **The New Charter of Mabalacat City College**, the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* of Mabalacat City empowers the Board of Trustees to exercise and perform such other powers and functions not inconsistent with existing law or ordinance as it may deem necessary for the effective and efficient governance of the College;

**WHEREAS**, the Academic Council Meeting convened by the Vice President for Academic Affairs, Dr. Renato Dan A. Pablo II, and attended by the Academic Affairs Unit Heads recommended for the merging of the two (2) existing institutes, the Institute of Arts and Sciences (IAS) and the Institute of Teacher Education (ITE)

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of the New Mabalacat City College Charter in Article II Section 3, Objectives (b) continuously evaluate educational programs to ensure high standard, quality, and relevance in delivery and (c) develop research in different disciplines to improve existing knowledge and practices.

**WHEREAS**, in order to maximize the utilization of IAS and ITE personnel in terms of Faculty loadings and the utilization of lecture rooms and laboratories, the merger of the two institutes was found feasible.

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to fill the vacant position as Dean in the Institute of Arts and Sciences by January 31, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, as per CHED Memorandum Order and ALCUCOA recommendations, the Dean of the Institute of Arts Sciences must be a Doctorate Degree holder;

**WHEREAS**, the incumbent Dean of the Institute of Teacher Education, Dr. Renalyn N. Gacusan, is a Doctorate Degree holder, therefore satisfying the aforementioned requirement;

**WHEREAS**, the combined student population of IAS and ITE is evidently lesser than that of the Institute of Computing Studies (ICS) and the Institute of Hospitality and Tourism Management (IHTM) which has only one (1) Dean managing the respective Institutes. This is manifested in the following data from the Registrar as of 1<sup>st</sup> Semester, AY 2019-2020:

**WHEREAS**, the merger of the two Institute will be cost effective and it will maximize the utilization of IAS and ITE personnel in terms of facility of IAS and ITE, with reference to the aforementioned, proves to be a viable, economic, and cost-effective measure that will benefit the College and its operations.

**WHEREAS**, during the Academic Council meeting, there was a unanimous decision to name the soon-to-be combined institutes as Institute of Arts, Sciences and Teacher Education (IASTE);






