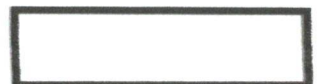

APPROVAL OF ACADEMIC RESOLUTION NO. 5 - "AN ACADEMIC RESOLUTION FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE PROPOSED ADMISSION POLICY ON MINIMUM GPA REQUIREMENT FOR OFFICE ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023"

WHEREAS, Article III Section 6 of the City Ordinance No. 60 s. 2016 otherwise known as The New Charter of Mabalacat City College, provides that the carrying out and performance of the general powers and functions of Mabalacat City College are vested exclusively [in] the Board of Trustees;

WHEREAS, Article II section 7 (d) of the New Charter of Mabalacat City College, the the Board of Trustees shall approve policies on admission, retention and graduation of students upon recommendation of the appropriate council or committee;

WHEREAS, in the Academic Council Meeting convened on June 8, 2022 by the Vice President for Academic Affairs, Dr. Michael A. Mesa, and attended by the members of the Academic Council, the Academic Council unanimously recommended in its *Resolution No. 05, series of 2022 – An Academic Resolution for the Approval of the Proposed Admission Policy on Minimum GPA Requirement for Office Administration Program for the Academic Year 2022-2023* that the minimum GPA requirement for the Office Administration Program for AY 2022-2023 will be SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT (75%), with the appropriate level of literacy and numeracy skills;

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees of Mabalacat City College approves the said recommendation of the Academic Council in its RESOLUTION NO. 05 - APPROVAL OF ACADEMIC RESOLUTION NO. 5 - "AN ACADEMIC RESOLUTION FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE PROPOSED ADMISSION POLICY ON MINIMUM GPA REQUIREMENT FOR OFFICE ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023".

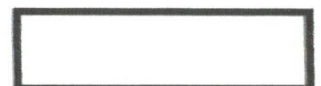
