APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN MABALACT CITY COLLEGE AND PHILIPPINE AIRFORCE

WHEREAS, Article III Section 6 of the City Ordinance No. 60 s. 2016 generally known as The New Charter of Mabalacat City College, the Sangguniang Panlungsod empowers Mabalacat City College to exercise the general powers prescribed by this Ordinance in order to carry out and perform the powers and functions are hereby vested exclusively by the Board of Trustees;

WHEREAS, Article II section 7 (q), of the City Ordinance No. 60 s. 2016 generally known as The New Charter of Mabalacat City College, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mabalacat City empowers the Board of Trustees to exercise and perform such other powers and functions not inconsistent with existing law or ordinance as it may deem necessary for the effective and efficient governance of the College;

WHEREAS, republic act no.9163 (RA 9163, otherwise know as the "National Service Training Program act of 2001"), mandates the establishment of National Service Training Service Program (NSTP), which shall form part of the curricula of all baccalaureate degree courses and of at least two (2) year technical -vocational courses as a requisites for graduation.

WHEREAS, the National service Training Program (NSTP) Act of 2001 is aimed at enhancing civic consciousness and defense preparedness in the youth by developing the ethics of service and patriotism while undergoing training in any of these three program companies: the reserved officers Training Corps, Civic Welfare Training Service, and the Literacy Training Service.

WHEREAS, the Mabalacat City College being an institution of higher learning is required to offer the mandatory NSTP or at least one of the program components thereof.

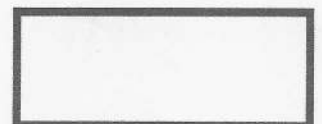
