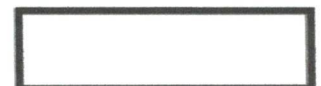

LIFTING THE DEFERMENT OF THE COLLECTION OF CONTINGENT DEPOSIT

WHEREAS, Article III Section 6 of the City Ordinance No. 60 s. 2016 otherwise known as The New Charter of Mabalacat City College, provides that the carrying out and performance of the general powers and functions of Mabalacat City College are vested exclusively [in] the Board of Trustees;

WHEREAS, Article II section 7 (I) of the New Charter of Mabalacat City College provides that the Board of Trustees shall fix a reasonable amount of tuition and matriculation fees, graduation fees, miscellaneous fees, laboratory fees and all other special fees and charges;

WHEREAS, on the 3rd Regular Board of Trustees meeting of Mabalacat City College convened on July 22, 2021, the Board unanimously recommended the deferment of Board Resolution No. 17 series of 2021 - "COLLECTION OF CONTINGENT DEPOSIT" since the collection of contingent deposit will not serve its purpose since there were no face-to-face classes that year;

WHEREAS, in the upcoming school year, Mabalacat City College will now be conducting face-to-face classes, and the collection of contingent deposit may now be implemented. Contingent deposit serves as guarantee of indemnity for damage a student may cause while inside the campus. The balance of which will be returned to the student as stated in Board Resolution No. 17, series of 2021;

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees of Mabalacat City College (MCC) approves the **LIFTING OF THE DEFERMENT OF THE COLLECTION OF CONTINGENT DEPOSIT**;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that in consideration of those who do not have the capacity to pay immediately, they will be given an ample amount of time to pay the contingent deposit;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that a copy of this resolution be furnished to the offices concerned.
