WHEREAS, Article II section 7 (q) of the New Charter of Mabalacat City College provides that the Board of Trustees shall exercise and perform such other powers and functions not inconsistent with existing law or ordinance as it may deem necessary for the effective and efficient governance of the College;

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) No. 10931, otherwise known as the Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education Act is "an act promoting universal access to quality tertiary education by providing free tuition and other school fees in State Universities and Colleges, Local Universities and Colleges, and State-Run Technical-Vocational Institutions, establishing the Tertiary Education Subsidy and Student Loan Program, strengthening the Unified Student Financial Assistance System for Tertiary Education, and appropriating fund therefore," as stated in the title of the Law;

WHEREAS, Mabalacat City College (MCC) is a beneficiary of Republic Act 10931, as implemented through the Unified Student Financial Assistance System for Tertiary Education (UNIFAST) of the Commission on Higher Education (CHED);

WHEREAS, The MCC executives and managers during their planning last January 10, 2023, passed and approved, for the recommendation to the Board, the total allocation of CHED-UNIFAST Budget for 2023 amounting to FIFTY-EIGHT MILLION THREE HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND AND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (Php 58,315,500.00), with the following breakdown:
