WHEREAS, Article III Section 6 of the City Ordinance No. 60 s. 2016 otherwise known as The New Charter of Mabalacat City College, provides that the carrying out and performance of the general powers and functions of Mabalacat City College (MCC) are vested exclusively [in] the Board of Trustees;

WHEREAS, Article II section 7 (q) of the New Charter of Mabalacat City College provides that the Board of Trustees shall exercise and perform such other powers and functions not inconsistent with existing law or ordinance as it may deem necessary for the effective and efficient governance of the College;

Approving the Opening of the Online Application for Admission for the 1st Semester of Academic Year 2024-2025

Excerpt from the minutes of the meeting during the Special Academic Council Meeting of A.Y. 2023-2024, held on December 05, 2023, via Microsoft Teams

WHEREAS, the Special Academic Council Meeting was convened by the OIC- Vice President for Academic Affairs for Curriculum and Innovative Strategies, Marilyn Sarabia-Arcilla, and attended by the Academic Council members and Assistant Vice President Support for Academic and Institutional Development for Admissions, in line with the discussed Opening of Online Application for Admission.

WHEREAS, Mabalacat City College is committed to its mission of having an open admission policy.

WHEREAS, MCC caters to the educational needs of its community, enabling its clientele to have access to quality and transformative education.

WHEREAS, MCC will open its online application admission for the 1st semester of the Academic Year 2024-2025 on December 12, 2023, and will end on February 12, 2024.

WHEREAS, no specific grade requirements will be imposed for admission applications from incoming first-year students; however, applicants will be required to undergo the College Entrance Exam (CEE), which utilizes standardized tests measuring Verbal, Numeric, and Abstract Aptitude;

WHEREAS, Interviews will constitute a segment of the admissions process, following the approved interview guidelines specifically established for the Institute of Business Education (comprising BS Office Administration, BS Management Accounting, BS Information Technology, BS Entrepreneurship, and BS Customs Administration), the Institute of Hospitality and Tourism Management (including BS Hospitality Management and BS Tourism Management), and the Institute of Teacher Education (offering BSEd in English and Bachelor of Physical Education). Candidates will be selected based on average performance in alignment with Admissions College Entrance Exam norming guidelines;

WHEREAS, for all other institutes without interviews, applicants must attain at least an average level in their CEE results and will be ranked accordingly, taking into account program slot availability and residency;

WHEREAS, applicants who are official residents of Mabalacat City shall be given priority, comprising 85% of admissions. Applicants who are non-residents of Mabalacat City, making up 15%, shall be considered provided they competitively meet the top rank among applicants, where further deliberation may ensue.

WHEREAS, specialized admissions programs such as the UN students, the I-peace program for members of indigenou disabilities will automatically qualify for admission;



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WHEREAS, the TOP 100 students during the College Entrance Exam will undergo screening for the Crimson Honors program;

WHEREAS, the Institute of Arts and Sciences will not accept transferees;

WHEREAS, the Institute of Hospitality and Tourism Management and the Institute of Business and Computing Education will not admit transferees but will welcome returnees;

WHEREAS, the Institute of Teacher Education (ITE) will accept both transferees and returnees for the following programs: Bachelor of Early Childhood Education, Bachelor of Secondary Education majoring in Filipino, Bachelor of Secondary Education majoring in Social Studies, Bachelor of Secondary Education majoring in Science, and Bachelor of Technical Vocational Teacher Education.
