



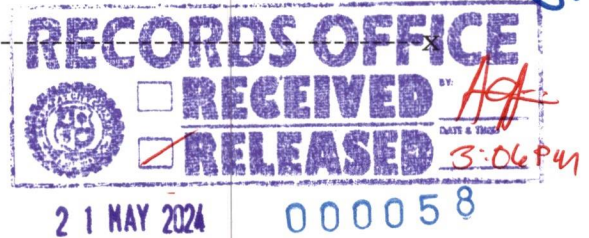

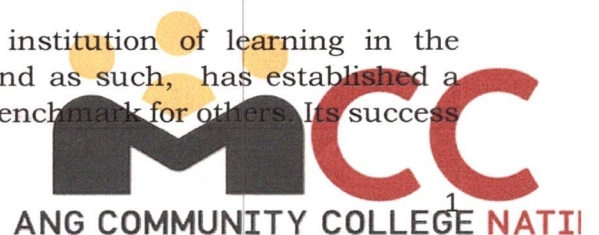


APPROVING THE DRAFT BILL FOR THE CONVERSION OF MABALACAT CITY COLLEGE INTO THE NATIONAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF THE PHILIPPINES (NCCP)

WHEREAS, Article III Section 6 of the City Ordinance No. 60 s. 2016 generally known as **The New Charter of Mabalacat City College**, the Sangguniang Panlungsod empowers Mabalacat City College to exercise the general powers prescribed by this Ordinance in order to carry out and perform the powers and functions are hereby vested exclusively by the Board of Trustees;

WHEREAS, Article II section 7 (q), of the City Ordinance No. 60 s. 2016 generally known as **The New Charter of Mabalacat City College**, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mabalacat City empowers the Board of Trustees to exercise and perform such other powers and functions not inconsistent with existing law or ordinance as it may deem necessary for the effective and efficient governance of the College;

WHEREAS, Mabalacat City College is the pioneer institution of learning in the Philippines with the community college framework. And as such, has established a positive reputation among its peers and has become a benchmark for others. Its success

positions it as exemplary model for other local colleges and universities and heralds its potential to serve as the premier training center for the country's community college framework.

WHEREAS, it is proposed that Mabalacat City College be converted to a National Community College, solidifying its role as a pioneer and champion for community college framework.

WHEREAS, during its special meeting held on February 16, 2024, the Board of Trustees was informed of the proposal and the proposed bill was presented to the Board for its review and recommendation. The Board also decided to conduct consultations to all the stakeholders of Mabalacat City College

WHEREAS, on April 8, 2024, a Town Hall meeting was held in Mabalacat City College to consult all the stakeholders of the plan to convert Mabalacat City College to National Community College of the Philippines.

WHEREAS, as a result of the Town Hall Meeting, an Open Letter of Support was executed by the employees and students expressing their support for the institution's transformation into the National Community College of the Philippines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees **APPROVES** the draft bill for the conversion of Mabalacat City College into the National Community College of the Philippines subject to revisions that may be introduced in latter dates.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that a copy of the resolution be given to Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mabalacat City and to the Police Station of Mabalacat City for information.
