Academic Resolution Approving Make-up classes for affected courses due to some student activities, Advanced Classes and Change of Modality

WHEREAS, the 6th Academic Council Meeting was convened by the OIC Vice President for Academic Affairs, Marilyn S. Arcilla, PhD and attended by the members of the Academic Council.

WHEREAS, make-up classes or advanced classes are mandatory for courses affected by student activities:

WHEREAS, the VPAA will carefully examine student activity proposals before approving them, prioritizing academic continuity;

WHEREAS, make-up classes should be properly documented and filed by the affected faculty members;

WHEREAS, faculty must submit faculty loadings and make-up form recommended for approval by the dean of the institute;

WHEREAS, make-up classes can be conducted in various modalities, including face-toface, online, or advanced classes, as deemed appropriate by the VPAA;

WHEREAS, advanced classes are acceptable as an alternative to make-up classes, provided they are approved by the faculty member and the OVPAA;

WHEREAS, the Student Life Office will continue to filter student activities, prioritizing those aligned with the college's academic mission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Academic Council approves the makeup classes, advanced classes and change of modality for affected courses due to some student activities.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that make-up classes, advanced classes, and change of modality be implemented effective immediately upon the approval of the Academic Council.
