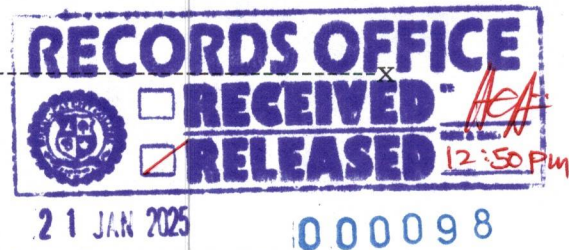

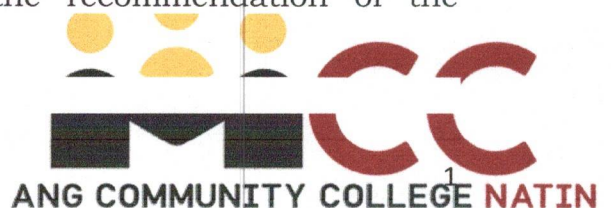


**APPROVING THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO.12**

WHEREAS, encourage faculty and students to conduct research and innovation projects that address SDG-related challenges. Institutions should provide resources and platforms for disseminating research findings and fostering a culture of knowledge sharing around sustainable practices.




