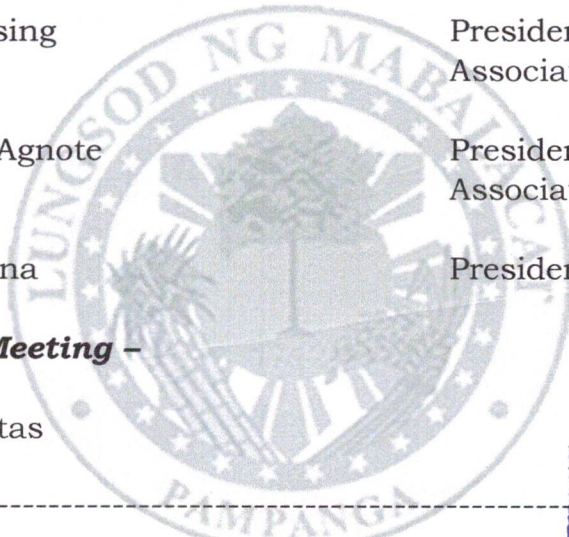

“Approving the Opening of Online Application Admission for the 1st Semester of Academic Year 2025-2026”

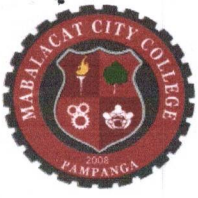




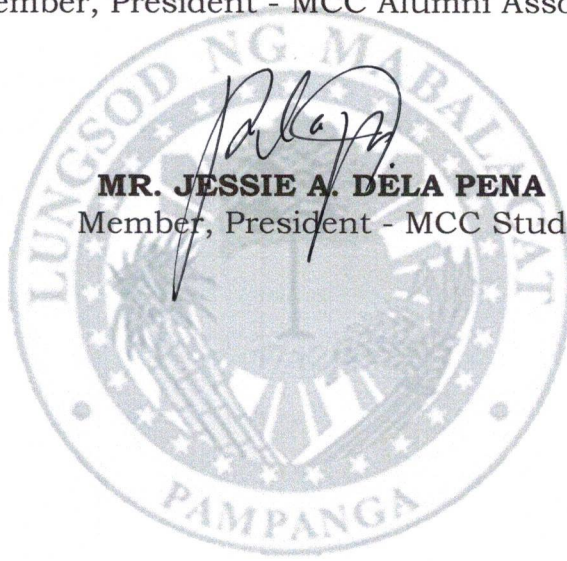
