II. OBJECTIVE

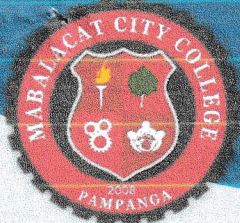
- To provide insights to all the MCC students, faculty, teaching, non-teaching personnel, and other residents of Mabalacat City about the essence of nationalism.

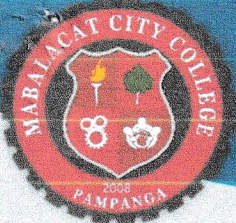




