PROJECT TITLE: International Day of Peace Celebration 2023 - Food

RATIONALE: The International Day of Peace, observed annually on September 21st, serves as a reminder of the urgent need for global peace and the prevention of conflict. In a world marked by geopolitical tensions, armed conflicts, and social injustices, this day provides an opportunity to reflect on the importance of peace and the collective efforts required to attain it. Peace is not merely the absence of war; it encompasses social, economic, and political stability, as well as the promotion of human rights and well-being for all.

OBJECTIVES:

1. To raise global awareness about the significance of peace and the devastating consequences of war and violence.
2. To encourage students, staff, and communities to prioritize peaceful conflict resolution.
3. To empower students in peace-building activities, education, and advocacy, recognizing their potential as agents of positive change.

SDGs:

Goal 4 Quality Education – This goal ensures inclusive and equitable quality education and promotes lifelong learning opportunities for all.

Goal 16 Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions – It aims to significantly reduce all forms of violence, and work with governments and communities to end conflict and insecurity. Promoting the rule of law and human rights are key to this process, as is reducing the flow of illicit arms and strengthening the participation of developing countries in the institutions of global governance.

BACKGROUND:

MCC is launching another program concerning SDG 16 (on Peace) and SDG 4 (On Global Citizenship Education), as it celebrates the International Day of Peace on September 21. Last year, MCC started the World Peace Flag Ceremony, Peace Walk, Peace Concert, Peace Sign Human Formation, and Paper Crane Origami making. This year, the theme of the Peace Day Celebration is PEACetival with an adoption of the UN's theme: Actions for Peace, Our Ambition for the Global Goals.
