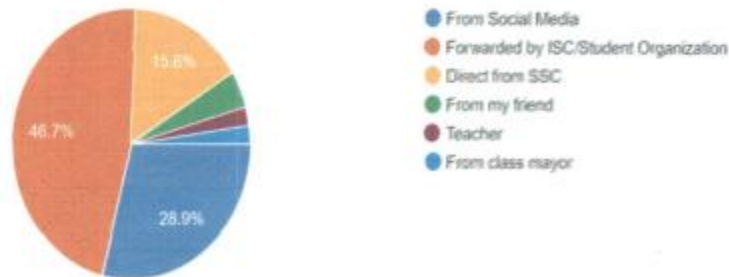

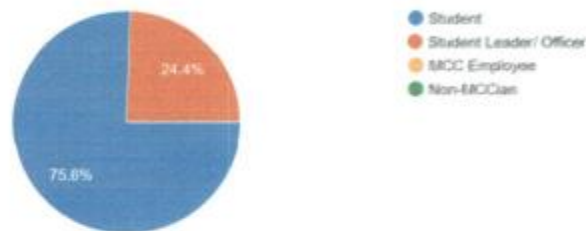

Based on the pie chart above, 75.6% of the participants of the said event are all students while 24.4% are from Student leader/Officers.

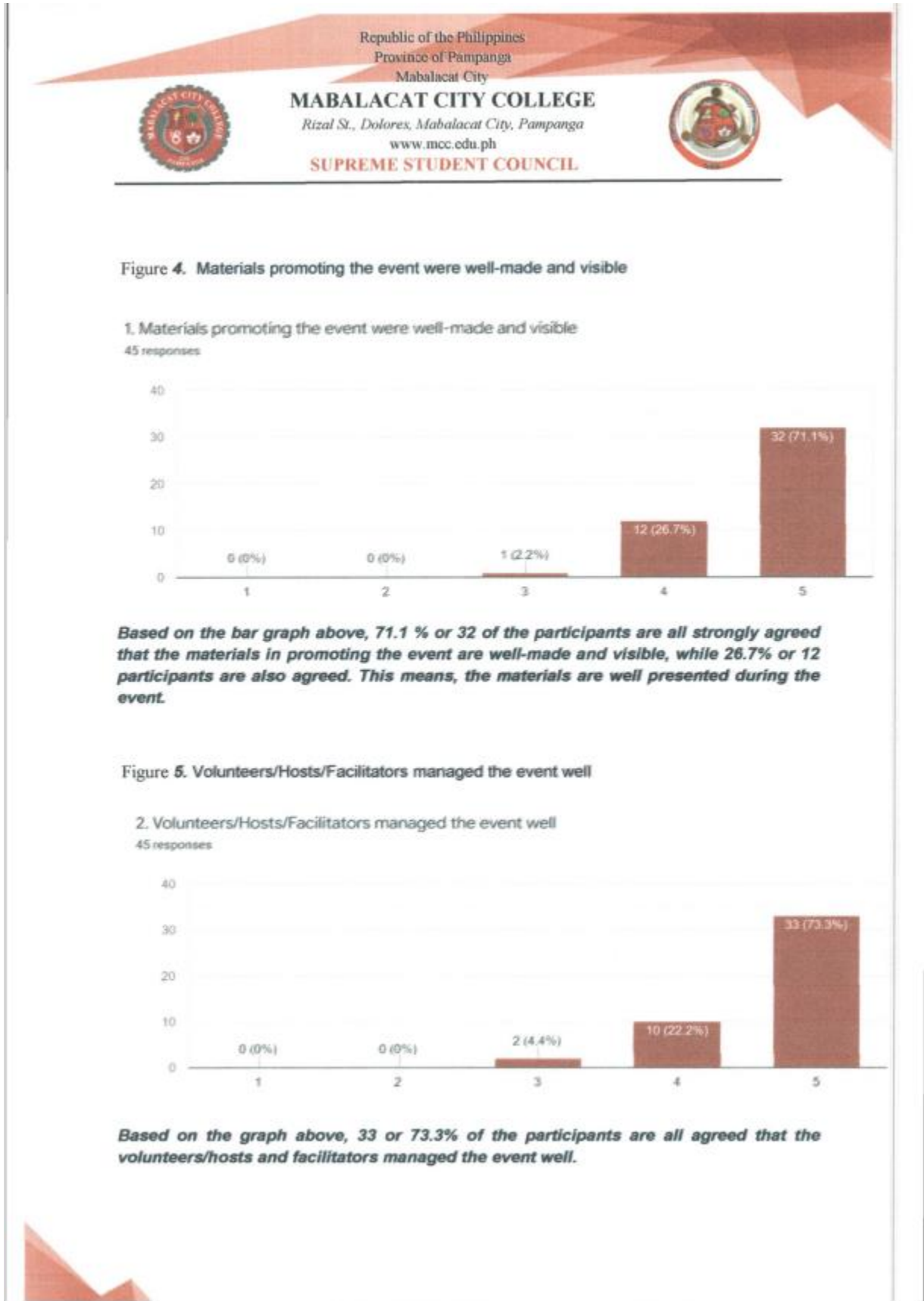
Figure 3. Age Range

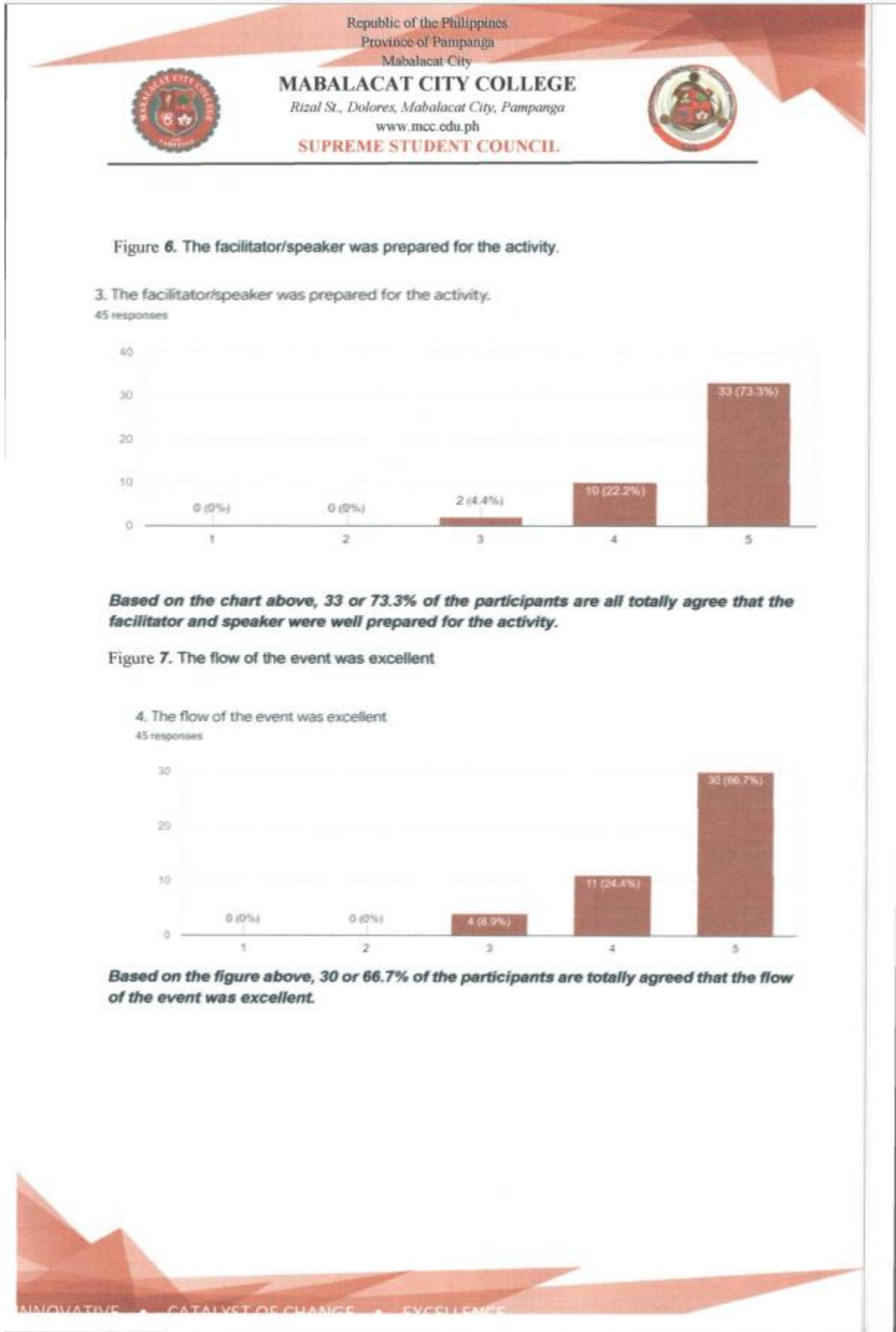
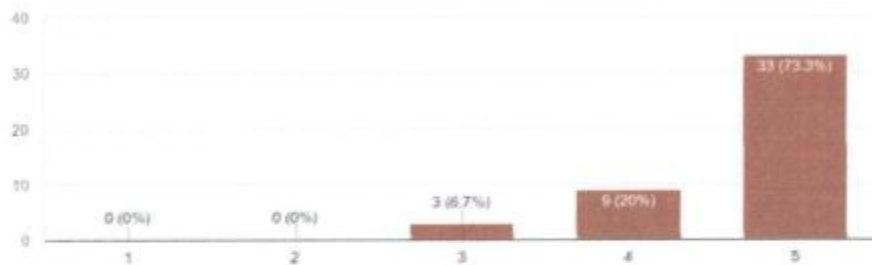




Figure 8. Time allotted for the event was sufficient for its purpose

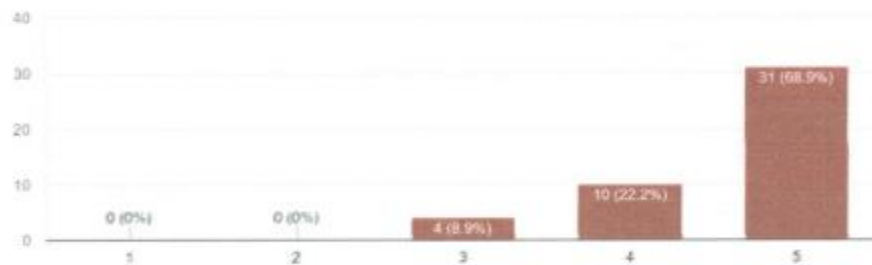

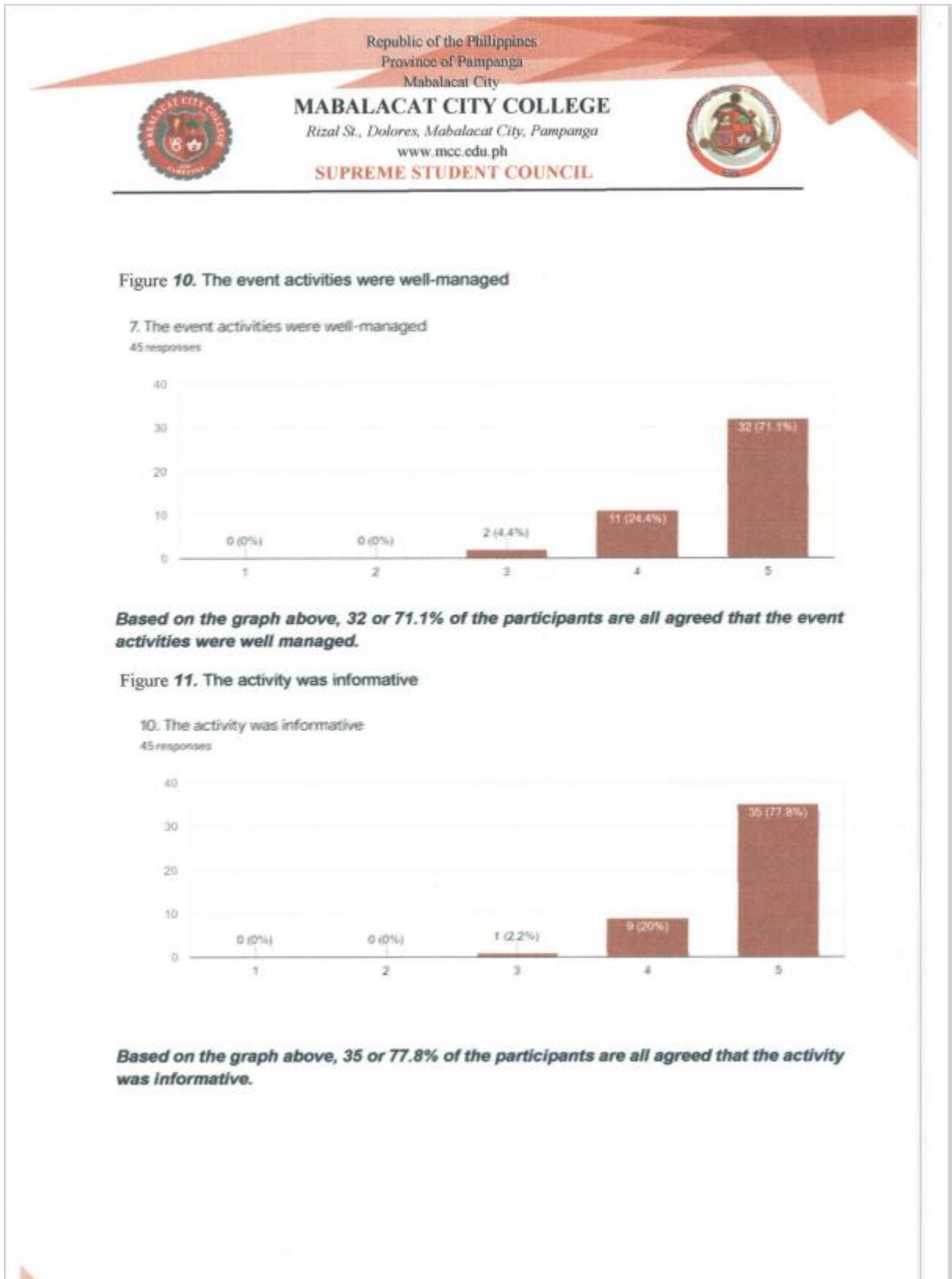

From 254 responses, 36.6% are first year, 8.7% are second year, 25.2% are third year and 29.5% are fourth year. There are 33.5% responses from IASTE, 15.7% responses from IBE, 8.3% from ICS while 42.5% responses are from IHTM.

Out of 3,790, the total population of student from first semester, 253 are the total responses who participate in the post evaluation survey and which is actually 6.68%.

Therefore, we conclude that the Crimson Tribe Lantern Festival 2021 was successfully managed and organized since more than majority of the responses are satisfied with the said event.

According to Republic Act 7719, also known as the National Blood Services Act of 1994, Section 2 subsection a, it is hereby declared the policy of the State to promote and encourage voluntary blood donation by the citizenry and to instill public consciousness of the principle that blood donation is a humanitarian act.

Also included in the Section 2 subsection c of this act the provision to provide for adequate, safe, affordable and equitable distribution of supply of blood and blood products.

Stipulated in the Section 2 subsection e of this act the policy of the State to teach the benefits and rationale of voluntary blood donation in the existing health subjects of the formal education system in all public and private schools, in the elementary, high school and college levels as well as the non-formal education system.

As per CHED Memorandum No. 09 s. 2013, Section 27 entitled Health Services subsection 27.1, the Higher Education Institution shall provide primary health care services administered by licensed medical, dental and allied professionals to all students.

In compliance with this, the Mabalacat City College Supreme Student Council (MCCSSC) with the collaboration of the Mabalacat City College Health Services Unit, Mabalacat City Health Office, Pampanga Provincial Health Office and Jose B. Lingad Memorial General Hospital will be conducting an activity entitled *“Every Blood Donor is a Hero”* on May 23, 2022. The activity aims to enhance the awareness of society about the importance of blood donation services to prolong and save the life of Filipino Citizens.

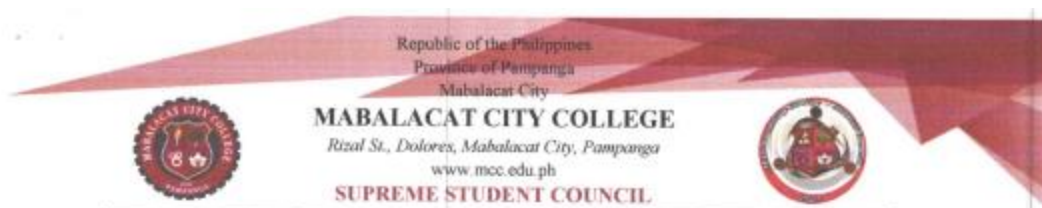

Table 4 above indicated with a mean of 129.85 or 51.12 % of the total respondents are strongly agreed in all indicators to the event.
