PROJECT PROPOSAL

SegKo: Segregation and Collection of plastic bottle waste of Mabalacat City College

I. Rationale

The Philippines was crowned as the third largest contributor of global plastic waste in 2022 and is nicknamed as the "sachet economy" of the world. The problem stems from the over packaging of products and improper solid waste management that occurs at the community level.

Mabalacat City College has made efforts to reduce local pollution by providing waste bins and requiring student leaders to ensure cleanliness after every event. 


III. Strategies


