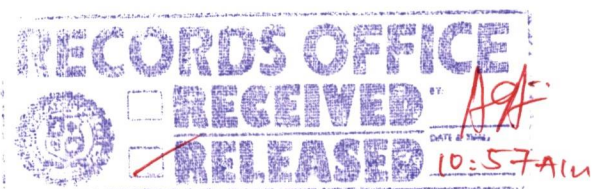
**OBJECTIVES:**

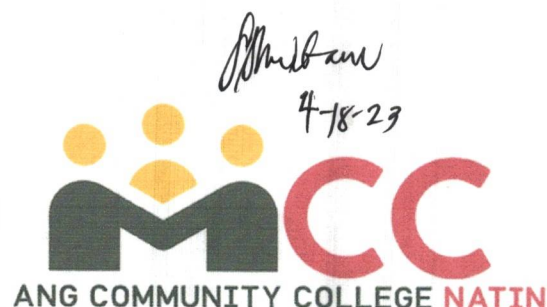
