
#### **DURATION OF SCHOLARSHIP**

In 2022, under the leadership of the new Board President, the scholarship program extended its grant assistance to applicants in their 2nd through 4th years of study. As a result, eligibility for the scholarship became contingent on the applicant's current year of study at the time of their application.



## TERTIARY EDUCATION SUBSIDY (TES) SCHOLARSHIP GRANT

#### **ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP**

The Tulong Dunong Program (TDP), commonly referred to as CHED-TDP, is one of several scholarship initiatives administered by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED). Designed to provide financial assistance to eligible and deserving Filipino students, this program is a collaborative effort between CHED and the Department of Budget and Management (DBM). Its primary objective is to alleviate the burden of educational expenses and tuition fees for students pursuing higher education.

#### PER SEMESTER

The UniFAST Secretariat will be responsible for ranking student applicants based on their per capita household income, in order to determine the distribution of available funds.

#### DURATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

Given the constraints of limited funds, the new Tertiary Education Subsidy (TES) slots for the first semester of Academic Year 2023-2024 will be distributed evenly between student applicants. All applicants will undergo a cross-matching and ranking process, utilizing the most up-to-date Listahanan data.

The Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) together granted this scholarship grant to help students with their educational expenses and tuition fees.

#### **DURATION OF SCHOLARSHIP**

The Tulong Dunong Scholarship is granted for a **(1) one academic year**, with the option for scholars to **renew** their application annually, provided they continue to meet the stipulated requirements and maintain their eligibility. To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must have achieved a General Weighted Average (GWA) of at least 80% in the preceding academic year or its equivalent.
