

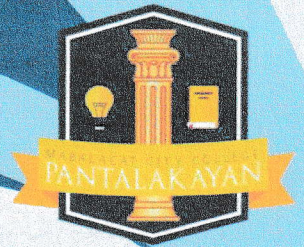
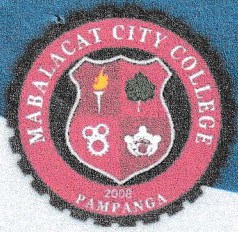

I. RATIONALE

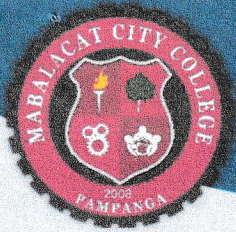

II. OBJECTIVE

- To exhibit and present a diverse collection of papers authored by both faculty and students of AB History Department of Mabalacat City College in a form of colloquium wherein attendees will gain valuable insights and guidance from these presentations, enabling them to deepen their comprehension of various historical aspects in the Philippines.

III. STRATEGIES

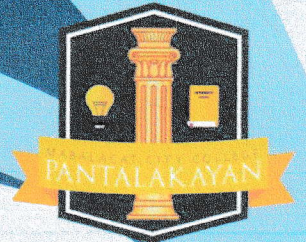
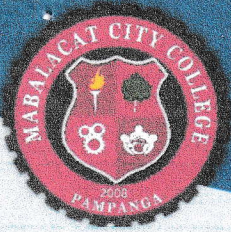
