
#SuperJuana highlights Women's Month Webinar


MCC External Affairs with the Internationalization unit concluded the month-long celebration of National Women's Month with no other than Dr. Amy Agigian, PhD. - a #SuperJuana from Suffolk University, Boston, Massachusetts USA. Dr. Agigian is the Director of the Center for Women's Health and Human Rights and also the Director of Our Bodies, Ourselves Today. She is an Associate Professor of the Department of Sociology and Criminal Justice of the same university.

The Women's Month Culminating Webinar highlighted the Socio-Cultural Aspects of Maternal Health and brought into the fore some issues that face women relative to maternal care and human rights. Dr. Amy discussed the different cases that undermine the well being of women who are pregnant and the choices that they have to make for themselves in order to remain mentally and physically well.

#thinkASEANfeelASEAN resonates ASIA





Mabalacat City College, through its Internationalization Office, is set to send a student to the Virtual Summer School of the University of Nottingham in Malaysia.

The University of Nottingham used to hold the annual summer school in face-to-face modality. However, this year, due to the health restrictions brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic, the University opted to cater the program to an online experience.

After a stringent screening of applicants, the Internationalization and Scholarships and Grants offices nominated Mr. Jim Bryn G. Balatero, a Bachelor of Science in Education, Major in Social Studies, for admission at the University of Nottingham's summer program.

Last June 17, 2021, he was formally accepted to participate on the course Politics, Culture, and the Media in Southeast Asia and will join eight students coming from the United Kingdom and one from Indonesia from July 5-16, 2021.





Texas, U.S.A. - Mabalacat City College (MCC) and Lone Star College (LSC) signed an MoU on June 14, 2022 (local time) to seal the collaboration and agenda the partner institutions plan to

Present during the signing were LSC's Dr. Dwight Smith, Mr. Mario Castillo, Dr. Carolyn Ho, Dr. Katharine Karuso and MCC's College President - Dr. Michelle Aguilar - Ong, who were all delighted at the idea of finally moving ahead at the implementation of the various programs lined up in the collaboration. The signing was virtually attended by some members of the MCC faculty and administration.

Through EducationUSA, a program of the US Embassy which promotes U.S. higher education to students around the world by offering current information about opportunities to study at accredited postsecondary institutions in the United States, both institutions were able to connect and join in collaborative projects. Months ago, even before the MoU, MCC and LSU already conducted collaborative projects such as the synchronous classes on ECE121 and the Collaborative Online International Learning or COIL to name a few. Edward Inong, a faculty member of MCC who participated virtually in the MoU signing said that, "...it is great to learn not only from one another here in MCC but also from exceptional professors on the other side of the world, particularly from Lone Star College." Another MCC faculty member Edmon Sampana who participated in the synchronous classes on ECE121 mentioned that, "this exposure or experience with the international academic community... is a good start to a more meaningful exchange of ideas, techniques, methodologies in teaching and learning."
